Figure 1: Gradient concentration CSFV amplification curve

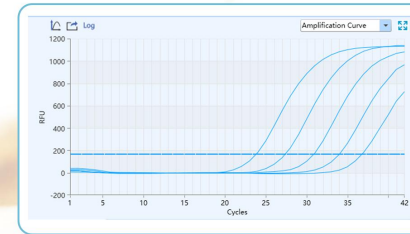
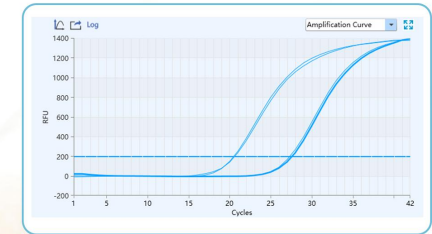


Figure 2: High concentration and low concentration CSFV repetitive amplification curve
